The monthly meetings are held on the first Tuesday of each month at 6:00pm, at the South Charleston Public Library. From 6:00 to 7:30 pm, the attendees have the opportunity to examine the coins submitted for the monthly auction. Also, there is a short business meeting with coin show and other related announcements, followed by a coin auction. The auction is open to the public, but the coins to be auctioned are submitted by active members. At the conclusion of the auction there is a drawing for door prizes for all paid members in attendance.

Annual club dues are currently \$12.00 for adults and \$6.00 for junior members. Members receive monthly auction lists and participate in door prize drawings at the end of the meeting.

The Kanawha Valley Coin Club was originally formed in 1960 as the Dunbar Coin Club. The club was incorporated in 1974 as the Kanawha Valley Coin Club. The purpose of the club is to provide an opportunity for those interested in numismatics to meet, exchange information, and buy & sell their coins to other collectors. The club strives to provide educational opportunities for the novice collector by allowing him or her to learn about their coins, coin collecting, coin grading, and various other aspects of numismatics.
